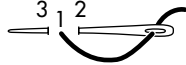


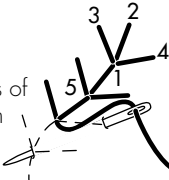
**BACKSTITCH**

Up at 1, down at 2, up at 3, down at 1, stitching back to meet previous stitch.



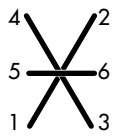
**FERN STITCH**

Make three straight stitches of equal length radiating from the same central point. Up at 1, down at 2, up at 1, down at 3, up at 1 down at 4, up at 5 to begin next group of stitches.



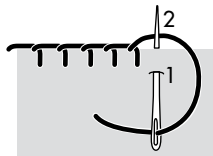
**OBLONG CROSS STITCH**

Up at odd, down at even numbers, working in numerical sequence.



**BLANKET STITCH**

Down at 1, up at 2, with thread below needle; pull through.



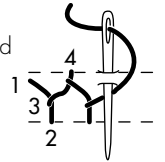
**FRENCH KNOT**

Up at 1, wrap thread once around needle, down at 1.



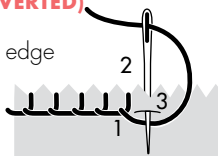
**OPEN CRETAN STITCH**

Up at 1, then holding thread above the needle, down at 2 and up at 3. Holding thread below the needle, down at 4 and up at 5.



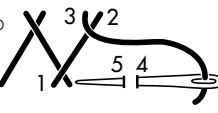
**BLANKET STITCH (INVERTED)**

Up at 1, around fabric edge at 2, up at 3 with thread below needle; pull through.



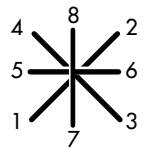
**HERRINGBONE STITCH**

Up at 1, down at 2, up at 3, down at 4; completes stitch. Up at 5 to work next stitch



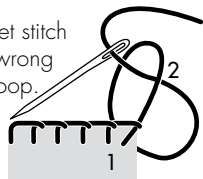
**SMYRNA CROSS**

Up at odd, down at even numbers, working in numerical sequence.



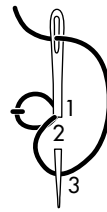
**BLANKET STITCH (CORNER)**

Make a diagonal blanket stitch at 1. Tack stitch on the wrong side at corner, leaving loop. Insert needle through loop at 2; pull taut. Continue stitching.



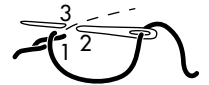
**LAZY DAISY STITCH**

Up at 1, make loop, down at 1. Up at 2, down at 3 to tack loop



**STEM STITCH**

Up at 1, down at 2, up at 3 keeping thread to left of needle and working slightly slanted stitches along the line of design.



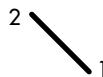
**CHAIN STITCH**

Up at 1, make loop, down at 1; up at 2 with thread looped under needle; pull needle through. Point 2 is now 1 for the next stitch.



**LONG/STRAIGHT STITCH (DIAGONAL)**

Up at 1, down at 2.



**WHIPSTITCH EMBROIDERY**

Use a whipping motion over the raw edges to finish.



**CROSS STITCH**

Stitch from lower left to upper right corner, then cross back. thread looped under needle; pull needle through. Point 2 is now 1 for the next stitch.



**LONG/STRAIGHT STITCH (HORIZONTAL)**

Up at 1, down at 2.



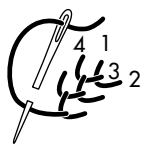
**LONG/STRAIGHT STITCH (VERTICAL)**

Up at 1, down at 2.



**FEATHER STITCH**

Up at 1, down at 2, up at 3 pulling through with thread under the needle. Up at 4 to make next even stitch, alternating stitches to right and left of 1.



**LONG/STRAIGHT STITCH**

Up at 1, down at 2. Work stitches for specified length.
