

Quilling Basics

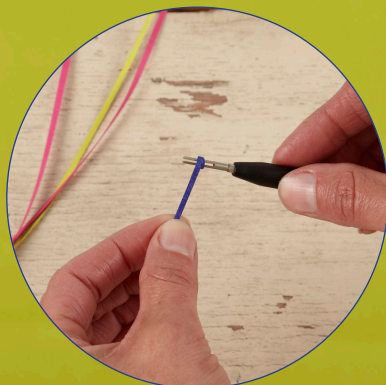
WHAT IS QUILLING?

Quilling is the art of rolling thin strips of paper to create shapes and designs.

WHAT DO I NEED?

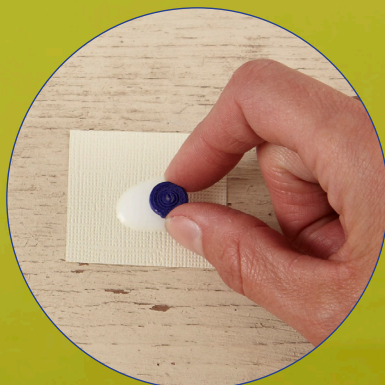
- ✓ Thin strips of paper (typically 1/8" wide), whether you cut them yourself or buy premade quilling strips at the craft store
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Tweezers
- ✓ Toothpick (or another quilling winder like a pencil, a needle or better yet, a quilling tool)
- ✓ Liquid glue

HOW DO I QUILL?



Roll paper strip around a paper piercer. Adhere end.

+



Dip quilled piece into liquid glue.

+



Adhere quilled piece to project.

BASIC QUILLING SHAPES



Tight Circle: Roll, remove strip from tool, and glue loose end.



Loose Scroll: Roll one end.



Loose Circle: Roll, remove strip from tool, allow to loosen. Glue loose end.



Open Heart: Crease strip at center. Roll each end toward the inside.



Teardrop: Make a loose circle; pinch one side.



V Scroll: Crease strip at center. Roll each end toward the outside.



Marquise: Make a loose circle and pinch both sides.



C Scroll: Roll both ends towards the center.
